

The Whitelist: Amplifiers

- Vox
 - **Class:** Amplifier **Training:** Hand-Eye
 - **Cost(Step):** 15 (5) **Force:** 2
 - **Feature(s):** 1; Trigger(5, Yellow)
 - **Scope:** Short-range, Everyone
 - Vox is a performance tool. It consists of a small neck strap and a wired, chorded finger control. A performer uses Vox to make people feel the emotion they are projecting with their voice, via audio harmonics. The words and presentation should back up that emotion. When an agent uses Vox, they decided what they want the listeners to feel, and then pick steps of intensity. That intensity plus five is the trigger challenge, and they risk mental injury caused by feedback from the device if they can't properly manage it with the finger control. The intensity of the emotion felt by the listener can be applied as a step penalty and bonus as the agent desires over the course of the current scene.
